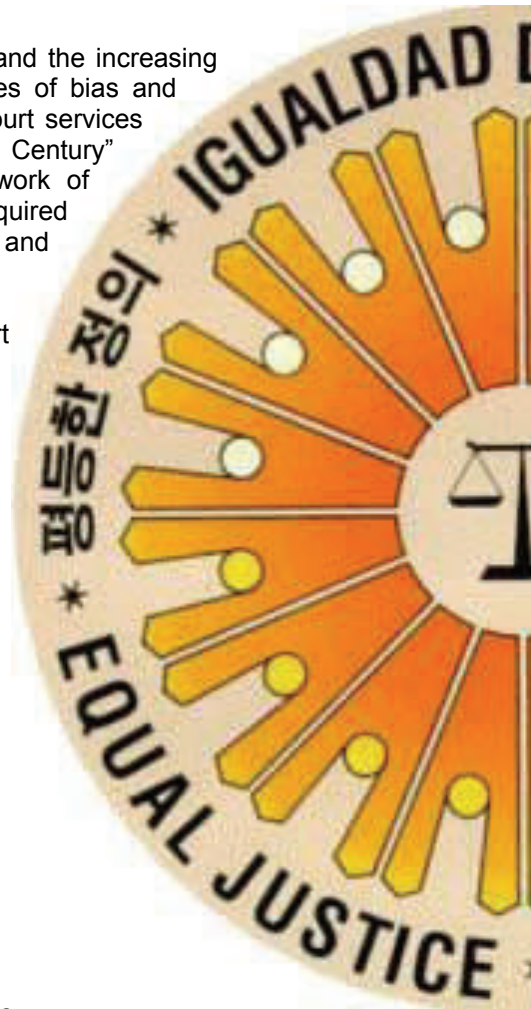
About the Conference
